Connected across borders

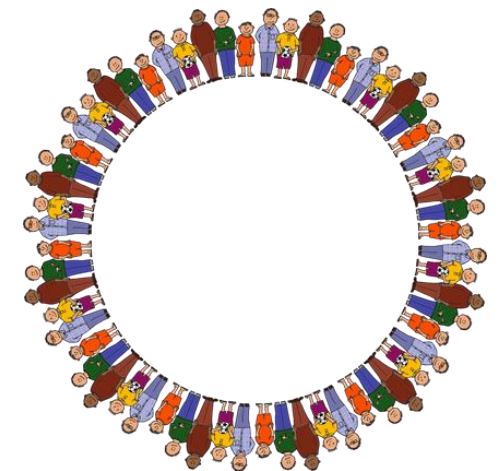
